      - i. a 1.99% increase in the Brighton & Hove element of the council tax; and
      - ii. no increase in the Brighton & Hove element of the council tax.
      - *iii. Any additional option for Council Tax emerging from public engagement work.*

  - 2.4 Allocate up to £50,000 in one-off resources towards an enhanced programme of communication and public engagement including a timely programme of advertising about the likely nature and impact of cuts on public services and a broader reach for the posted budget questionnaire.
