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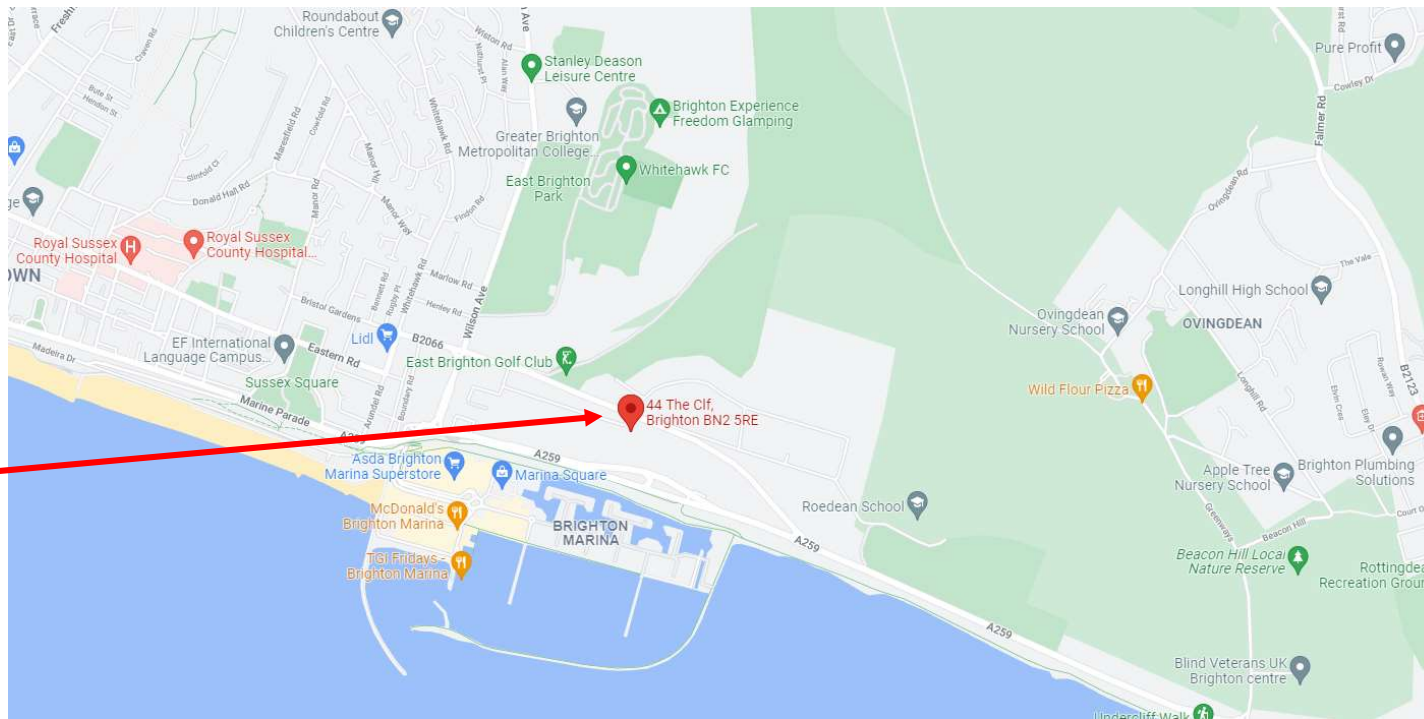
Application Description

- Revised fenestration at lower ground floor level to include 2no windows to replace existing window (retrospective).



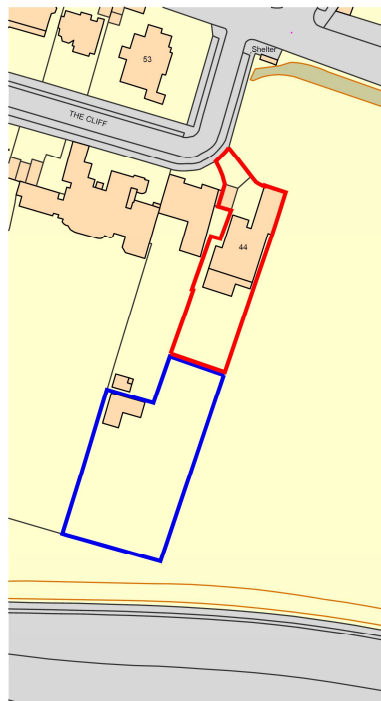
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Map of application site

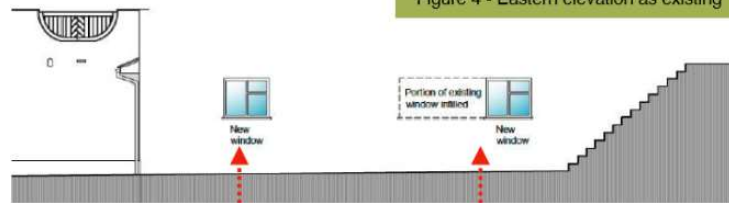
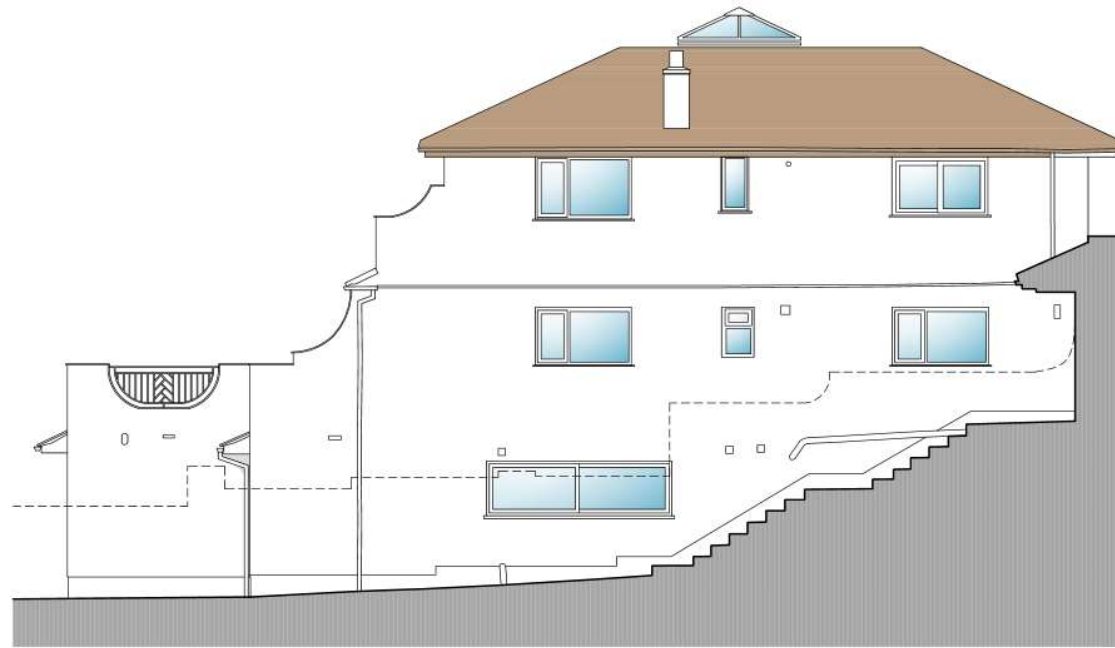


Figure 5 - New window positioned far south on the eastern elevation

Pre-Existing Part Side (Eastern) Elevation - Scale 1:100 @A3

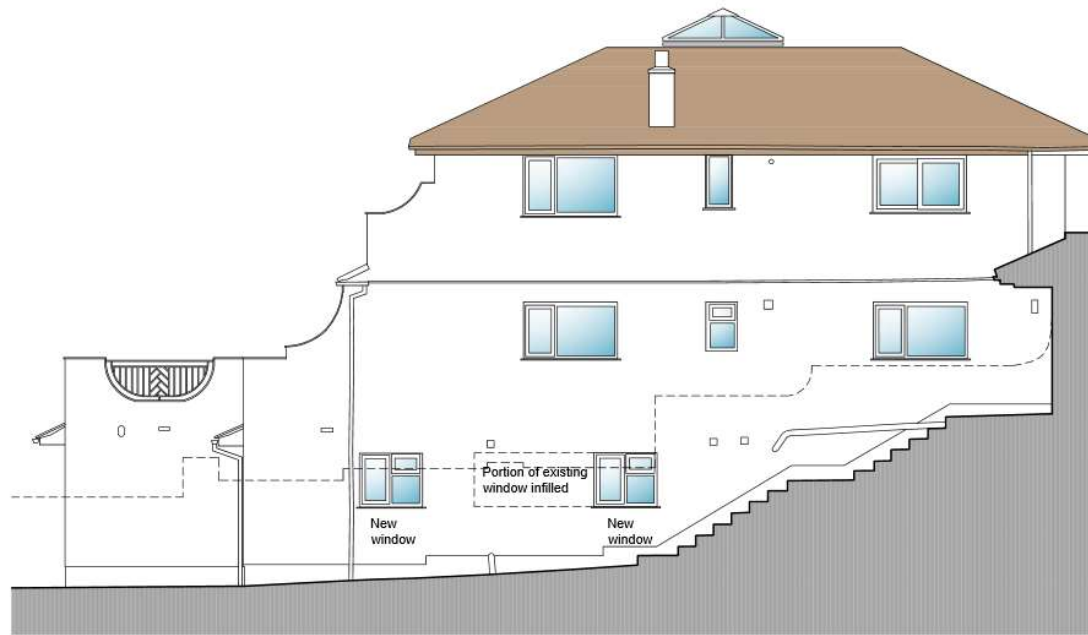


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Existing Side Elevation
