NOTICE OF OBJECTION under Section 104 (2) of the Licensing Act 2003

To whom it may concern,

Notice of objection is hereby given on behalf of the Chief Officer of Police for Sussex for the above Temporary Event Notice (TEN) on the grounds of the prevention of crime and disorder, public safety, public nuisance and protection of children from harm.

The TEN seeks to licence the sale by retail of alcohol (off the premises) during the following timings:

Sale by Retail of Alcohol

4th August 2018

10:00 - 23:00

5th August 2018

10:00 - 23:00

The premises itself is a phone box and the applicant would like to set up a pallet bar on the footpath alongside the phone box selling cocktails and possibly beer and cider. The premises does not hold a premises licence.

Sussex Police have the following concerns about this TEN application:

- The TEN offers limited information with no steps as to how the Licensing Objectives will be promoted e.g. Challenge 25 and the security of stocking the alcohol while open and overnight.
- This premises is situated on the New Road, which is one of the busiest areas in the City due to the theater and thoroughfare to the North Lanes. The phone box is on the side of New Road which we have been advised by the council, will not be closed despite what has been said within the application.
- The applicant has not consulted with Brighton Police Licensing prior to submitting the application.
- Due to the location being outside, the sale and supply will be made on the footpath thus possibly
 causing people to congregate on the pavement causing a pinch point. This will cause issues for
 vehicles and cyclist as well as other pedestrians. The road and footpath itself already merges in to one
 and not easily defined so does already cause some confusion to persons using it, especially people not
 local to the area.
- New Road itself has a number of issues with anti-social behavior. For this reason alone, Pavilion
 Gardens is closed off at times over the Pride weekend. The addition of a bar on the street providing
 alcohol raises Police concerns of this adding to the issues.
- To assistance with preventing a public nuisance and reduce the buildup of persons in that area, Sussex
 Police have already worked closely with two fully established licensed premises along New Road to
 ensure they have no pop up bars outside as well as speakers and or DJ's to which has been agreed.

The Chief Officer of Police contends that permitting the premises to be used in accordance with the notice is likely to lead to crime and disorder, risk to children and public safety and potentially cause issues with public nuisance. We therefore ask that a Counter Notice is issued by the Licensing Authority Committee to ensure the public are protected from harm and that the licensing objectives are not being undermined.
