## **Council-Led Actions to Support the Framework**

In contributing to the jointly developed priorities and actions articulated in the Framework, Brighton & Hove City Council will:

- 1. Seek investment / funding opportunities to support the delivery of the aims of the Cultural Framework and in doing so coordinate round table meetings to develop applications with appropriate stakeholders.
- 2. Review commissioning models at BHCC to align with the priorities of the Framework *Rethinking Our Place* work strand.
- 3. Ensure that the *Rethinking Our Place* work strand links explicitly to the established neighbourhood action plans & arrangements
- 4. Lead on the development of an events strategy in partnership with relevant stakeholders, linked to better use of public spaces The Brighton Experience work strand.
- 5. Lead on the development of a public art and public realm strategy in partnership with relevant stakeholders- The Brighton Experience work strand.
- 6. Lead on the development of a Heritage Strategy, in partnership with relevant stakeholders The Brighton Experience work strand.
- 7. Commission and deliver initiatives and projects (within agreed resources) where necessary to the effective delivery of the work strands.
- 8. Deliver a programme of "creative provocations" in partnership with University of Brighton, to maintain a public dialogue concerning cultural development.
- 9. Support the Arts & Creative Industries Commission to deliver an annual Summit to review progress of the Framework with all interested parties.
- 10. Create an annual report on progress following the annual cultural summit, to be presented to the Tourism, Development & Culture Committee.
- 11. Provide administrative support for the governance structure linked to the Cultural Framework delivery, including organising and servicing meetings (within agreed resources).
