1	35-39 The Droveaway, Hove	BH2017/04050	<p>Amendment to report:</p> <p>As an appeal has been lodged, the recommendation at 1.1 should omit the reference to refusing the application should the s106 Planning Obligation not be completed, and should read:</p> <p><i>That had the Council determined the application prior to an appeal being lodged, the decision of the council would have been to be Minded to Grant planning permission subject to the expiry of the re-consultation period and no new planning considerations arising, and subject to a s106 Planning Obligation and the Conditions and Informatives as set out hereunder:</i></p> <p>In addition, section 10.2 of the report should be omitted.</p> <p>Re-consultation:</p> <p>Following amendments and re-consultation, five letters have been received from neighbouring occupiers <u>objecting</u> to the application. In addition to the points already summarised in the report, the following additional comments have been made:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The amendments which have been made will not make any difference to the potential for increased traffic on The Droveaway. • The proposed commercial uses should be clarified. • The new build terrace of dwellings is too large, will cause overlooking, overshadowing, noise disturbance and light pollution. The dwellings should be two storey and windows and gardens should face southwards into the site rather than northwards towards the site boundary. • The submitted drawings do not show the levels of the application site /
