We, the undersigned, wish to protest in the strongest terms against the appalling decision to route the site traffic for Falmer Academy through the totally unsuitable residential roads of Moulsecoomb thereby putting the lives of our children, families and vulnerable older people at severe risk.

We call upon the Council to reverse this decision immediately and re-route the traffic via the existing service road which runs adjacent to the railway, through the University of Brighton to the Falmer Academy site.
