#### **APPENDIX D**

#### **Area L West Hove Review**

## **Background**

A resident parking scheme was implemented in the West Hove are (Area L) in 2018. It was agreed in the parking priority timetable set in 2019 that a review be carried out in 2021.

## **Headline Findings**

- 81.7% of respondents are satisfied or very satisfied with the current West Hove (Area L) parking scheme.
- 88% of respondents are happy for the scheme to remain the same
- 7.7% of respondents want the scheme changed to a full scheme

# Methodology

In November 2021, the council wrote to 2833 property addresses within the boundaries of the residents parking area (Area L). Respondents were invited to complete the survey online via the council's Consultation Portal: Citizen Space or paper copies of the questionnaire and a prepaid reply envelope were also available on request. The consultation ran from 1st to 30th November 2021.

#### Results

443 valid responses<sup>1</sup> were received from within the scheme boundary giving a response rate of 15.6%. People were asked how satisfied they are with the current Area L parking scheme?
