

## Data highlights (i)




- Numbers of Looked After Children have now levelled and are stable. There were 375 Looked After Children as at December 08
- Referrals to children's social care are relatively stable across the year with a slight downward trend overall. Low numbers reported in December reflect standard seasonal variation
- The steep rise in numbers of children subject to a child protection plan has now slowed and appears to be levelling. There were 247 children subject to a child protection plan as at December 08

## Arrangements to ensure the effectiveness of safeguarding practice:

- Appointment of a Director of Children's Services and designation of a Lead Member for children's services (Children Act 2004)
- Creation of a Local Safeguarding Children's Board (Children Act 2004
  - and Working Together 2006)
- Establishment of a Children and Young People's Trust to ensure planning and commissioning takes account of safeguarding and promoting welfare (Statutory Guidance 2008)
- Quality and Performance Branch to provide offline assurance including
  - safeguarding and child protection
- Area and city wide safeguarding and child protection services, including
  - internal management and assurance processes
- Integrated Safeguarding Children Training and Development Strategy

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# Summary of the assurance provided by external inspection



- CYPT safeguarding services judged to be adequate by the 2006 Joint Area Review, improving to good in the 2007 & 2008 APA
- All NHS Trusts in Brighton and Hove reported themselves compliant with Core Standard 2 Safeguarding Children in 2007/8
