## **Background**

There are a number of positions available and at the Area panels we will be electing to

- 1. Service Improvement Groups
- 2. Deputy Chair of the Area Panel
- 3. Strengthening Area Panels task and finish group
- 4. Tenant Disability Network

Residents were elected to the **Service Improvement Groups** for two years in 2013, with a second round of elections to fill gaps held in September. We are holding elections onto the groups to fill the spaces for one year. So there will be another round of elections to the Service Improvement Groups in September 2015.

As part of the decision to strengthen and reinvigorate Area Panels, each Panel will elect a resident representative as the **Deputy Chair**, working with and substituting for the councillor Chair.

We are also electing to the **Strengthening Area Panels task and finish group**, with one representative from each of the Area Panels, who will work with one representative from each of the special interest groups, and Chris El-Shabba and Ann Ewings who have already been elected from the Involvement & Empowerment Service Improvement Group.

We are also electing to the vacancies on the **Tenant Disability Network**.

#### **Service Improvement Groups**

A summary of the last meetings of the Service Improvement Groups is included in your Area Panel papers. The work of each of the groups is as follows:-

- Home Group repairs and maintenance and capital works
- Tenancy Group keeping housing areas safe and supporting vulnerable tenants

- Neighbourhood & Community Group keeping common areas clean and well maintained
- Involvement & Empowerment supporting tenants to be involved
- Business & Value for Money Group makes sure money is well spent.

All the groups meet at least four times a year; however with project work the groups are meeting more regularly. For example the Tenancy Group is working on a practical project to improve an estate, the Estates Development Budget Panel meets 10 times a year and the City Assembly Sub Group meets monthly. A reminder that representatives can only sit of one of the following:-Home, Tenancy & Neighbourhood and Community Groups.
